Re: RP condition after Stem Cell implanted

I was Identified by Doheny Eye Institute that I had RP in 1996. My left eye can see, if I turn 45 degree. But the right eye is still good but have poor vision field because of my narrow peripheral I have night blindness. Starting last year, I cannot tolerate the sun, especially in the morning; I cannot go east and go west when it's almost sunset. I can drive short distances just around my residence, not going out the way that I get used to. I have to remember all stop signs because I used to miss them. Sometime, traffic light just disappeared from my vision that was really dangerous. Three years ago, I started having hard times for shade and light when I change sudden light condition; my eye needs 2-4 minutes to adjust. I did not see stars in the sky for 15 years.

In 2006, Kaiser's doctor asked me to try Diamox; this medication brought me down so badly. He said that this medication could help my left eye seeing straight without turning 45 degree angle. I was not that bad before I had Diamox. I used to try Acupuncture too.

In June 2008, I went to see my optometry because I felt my vision getting worse. During the procedure, I found that my left eye almost blind. I just saw only the column on the left hand side, all other areas was all black no matter I asked doctor to turn 45 degree as I used to. I was stunned me dramatically. So, I got home and hopeless.

I searched online which way to get help with my RP until I found Dr. Sapse in July 2008 and I went to Mexico to see Dr. Gonzalez in November 2008 by getting strong referral from person names Diane Ashwood, in Australia which she has her Stem Cells implanted done in June 2008. She influenced me to move forward without hesitate with Dr. Sapse and Dr. Gonzalez.

Three months after my Stem Cell Implanted, my eye got more vision field for the area that already blind. I used to see about 25% of the screen on left hand side of my left eye. Now this eye has wide-open 100% from left to right. I noticed about first month but I am not too sure. So, I went to my Optometry that was exactly what I felt. My vision, in term of lens did not change much yet but I realized that I gained more color little by little from month to month. I tested with one picture in my room. This picture has background in white crème and tree painting. I started to see background this month as dark grey, the second month lighter gray and now I almost see in cream white but I could not tell what is the picture look like, yet. I talked about my left eye, which is blind eye. My right eye better than left eye a lot. Currently all my lenses had changed but I wait for two more weeks to see my optometry because I just saw him four weeks ago, at that time he said the old lenses OK, but now, I felt some changes that I need all new lenses. I want to share this Information to all RP community. My hope is on the way, I gain my strength and be positive and hopefully that my vision will get better day-by-day.

My RP was limited my ability to mobilize but never limited me to think and be creative. Lot of people that did not understanding RP conditions, they acted offensively at work. I hope, I can prove to these people that my brain functions properly fine, not jus my eye that lack of opportunity tike they are.

Finally, I want to deeply thanks from the bottom of my hearth to Dr. Sapse and Dr. Gonzalez to make my hope become real and be able to make my career up and beyond in the near future.

Her dad & I were having breakfast at the motel & I received a text message to get to her room NOW!...we went up and she was waving her arms to the sides of her head....and said she had been trying to see the TV in front of her, when she noticed that there was

something different...it was then that she realized there was a window in the room, and the light was streaming in. She put out her arms and could see her arm moving in the light. She "tested" it for a good time before telling us, wanting to be sure it was not imagined. She told us: "I can see my hand out to the side, but not how many fingers I am holding up". We then told her with our arms out like that neither could we. Later that morning, we were driving to the airport, Cori was watching (head facing forward) to see if she could tell what car/truck, etc. was coming up beside us...and she said, "I think this is a van & it looks dark blue or black"...it was a dark blue van.

Even one hour after the stem cell she said she could "feel" her kidneys. No pain, nothing definite, just knew they were there. She has had very little problem with her kidneys/bladder since the procedure...really none of the pain she had had before (she's had surgeries & numerous infections in the past, but only one bladder inflammation since treatment).

Later, about a month after treatment Cori and friends were outside at night & she asked them if there were any clouds in the sky...they said overcast, as usual (Seattle), and why was she wanting to know. She told them she thought she saw the outline of puffy clouds, and drew where she thought she saw them. They all laughed because she was outlining the treetops in the dark. Cori has been night blind for many years.

She is also now able to follow her hand & see her coffee cup on the table in front of her...something else she has not done for years...
